THE INNOVATIVE STRUCTURE & HISTORY OF THE HYLAND PEACE MASS

The traditional Mass in concert, as it has come to be delineated over the centuries, has five Latin parts reflecting those of the liturgical Latin mass, namely the Kyrie, Gloria, Credo, Sanctus, and the Agnus Dei.

When I commissioned Maltese maestro and composer Joseph Vella to author what he eventually insisted on naming The Hyland Mass in concert -a childhood aspiration realized- I explained to him my vision for a an innovative expanded Mass in concert structure.

I requested Maestro Vella compose music for four great works of secular literature and a text from The Old Testament, each of which would precede the classic five Latin texts, each sung in a different language. To date these parts have been sung in Maltese, Albanian, English, French, Italian and German. The texts are excerpts from John Donne, August Niemeyer, Alphonse de Lamartine, Dante, and The Old Testament, the Maestro making the original selection and he and I agreeing on them. I also commissioned a Peace Reveille (Call to Peace) to open the Mass in concert and a Peace Fanfare and Anthem to be performed at the end. Needless to say there were robust discussions regarding my vision.

I requested Maestro Vella employ unusual, if somewhat limited, ranges of notes, that there be a serious bass component, possibly at the beginning, that The Credo be characterized by two bass singers, and that there be grand soprano and large choral components. Eventually agreeing to do so, Maestro Vella composed only four of the five classic Latin parts including music for the free firm secular words preceding each part, the Credo section excluded. He composed the Fanfare and Anthem. Only much later, at first declining the concept, did he compose The Peace Reveille and, my authoring the lyrics, The Credo. It was an exciting, robust process, Maestro Vella's musical genius emerging each step of the way. He very publicly paid homage to our wonderful collaboration, every note of his music a Divine gift.

Whereas Maestro Vella composed the Fanfare and Anthem for the 2013 world premier concert at Saint George's Basilica, Victoria, Gozo, Malta, I recently substantially altered the lyrics, thus making the Pantheon performance of the Peace Fanfare and Anthem lyrics a world premiere.

The World Premier of The Hyland Peace Mass took place under the Patronage of then Bishop, now Mario, Cardinal Grech, and in the presence of U.S. Ambassador Gina Abercrombie-Winstanley at Saint George's Basilica, Rabat, Gozo, Malta, 15 July, 2013.

Subsequently, The Mass was performed at The Manoel Theatre, 6 September, 2013, at Saint Patrick's Cathedral, New York City, 9 November, 2016, and AMC Hall, Pristina, celebrating Kosova's fifteenth anniversary. Attending youth concerts, Hyland told Maestro Arthur Fiedler of The Boston Symphony Orchestra that, one day, he would have a mass just like Mozart's, repeating this wish over the decades, until he commissioned Joseph Vella.

Maestro Vella composed brilliant music for the ages, he and I agreeing that our collaboration be dedicated to fostering Understanding, Acceptance of Diversity, Inclusion, Accommodation and Peace.
